DATA SUBJECT RIGHTS

You may freely exercise your rights at any time under Reg. You have the right, at any time, to obtain from the Data Controller the access to personal data, request their rectification, erasure or processing restriction or the right to object anytime to your personal data processing. Furthermore you have the right to object to your personal data processing based on the legitimate interest, as well as to data portability. In order not to receive soft-spam email communications you have the right to contact the Data controller Without prejudice to any other administrative or judicial remedy, in case you consider your data processing in contrast with Reg. UE 2016/679, pursuant to article 15 lett. f) of Reg. UE 2016/679, you have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority – Italian Data Protection Authority (https://www.garanteprivacy.it/web/guest/home_en). In exercising your right to data portability, the Data Controller may provide your personal data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format.
